	determine under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Ballina Local				
	Environmental Plan 2012 and Ballina LEP 1987 to rezone and reclassify Council owned				
	land should proceed subje	ct to the following con	ditions:		
	1. The Planning Proposal is required to be updated prior to community consultation to include:				
	- updating Part 2 – Explanation of the Proposal to indicate what allotments are proposed				
	to have public reserve notations removed and what interests, if any, are proposed to be				
	retained.				
	- removing all written and map references to Lot 1 DP 604567.				
	2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the				
	Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:				
	(a) the Planning Proposal must be made publicly available for 28 days; and				
	(b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public				
	exhibition of Planning Proposals and the specifications for material that must be made				
	publicly available along with Planning Proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of 'A guide				
	to preparing local environ	nental plans (Planning	and Infrastructure, 2013)'.		
	3. Consultation is required	with the following put	blic authorities under section 56(2)(d) of		

	the EP&A Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
	(a) NSW Rural Fire Service
	4. A public hearing on the extinguishment of reserve designations is to be held in accordance with Section 57 of the EP&A Act 1979, after completion of the public exhibition period.
	5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
	6. Section 117 Directions - It is recommended that:
	(a) The Secretary's delegate can be satisfied that the Planning Proposal's inconsistency with s117 Directions 2.1 Environmental Protection Zones and 4.3 Flood Prone Land is of minor significance.
	(b) Consultation is required in relation to s117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection with the NSW Rural Fire Service
	(c) In relation to Direction 6.2 Reserving Land for Public Purposes, the Secretary's delegate agree to the reclassification of land for public purposes given that this land does not perform the function of open space and that the proposal is in accordance with Council's open space strategy.
	7. Plan making functions should not be delegated to Council, given that the Governor's approval is required to discharge interests.
Supporting Reasons :	The reasons for the above recommendations for the Planning Proposal are as follows:
	 The proposal will reclassify and rezone land that has reserve status but do not perform an 'open space function'. The proposal will facilitate the better management of infrastructure assets and new development opportunities on underutilised land.

	 (a) indicate what allotments are proposed to have public reserve notations removed and what interests, if any, are proposed to be retained; and (b) remove all written and map references to Lot 1 DP 604567. 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Act as follows: 				
	 (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; and (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013). 				
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	3. Consultation is required with the NSW Rural Fire Service under section 56(2)(d) of the Act. NSW Rural Fire Service is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.			
	 A public hearing on the extinguishment of reserve designations is to be held in accordance with Section 57 of the Act after completion of the public exhibition period. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the 			
	date of the Gateway determination.			
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
