Planning Proposal to amend Byron LEP 2014 –Additional Permitted Uses, The Farm, Ewingsdale

Council, at its Ordinary Meeting of 14 December 2017 received a report - *PLANNING* - 26.2016.6.1 – *Planning Proposal* – *The Farm* – *Additional Permitted Uses*, and resolved:

17-671 - Resolved:

- 1. Agree to initiate the Planning Proposal to amend Byron LEP 2014 (Attachment 1 #E2017/103796) for the reasons outlined in this report.
- 2. Forward the Planning Proposal to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment for a Gateway Determination.

As the planning proposal is not considered to be 'low impact' as outlined in the Department of Planning and Infrastructure's, *A guide to preparing local environmental plans*, a 28 day public exhibition period is recommended.
