Report by Director, Development & Customer Services:

Reason for report

The purpose of this report is to commence the review of items deferred out of the Blue Mountains Draft Local Environmental Plan 2013 (DLEP 2013). The process involves:

- Advising the Council of the process involved in processing the items deferred out of DLEP 2013 with the aim of these sites being included in the final city wide LEP;
- Review the sites and issues relevant to the deferred items; and
- Preparing recommendations for each of the sites.

Background

In July 2012, the Council received a letter from the then Minister for Planning requiring Council to prepare a new principal LEP based on the Standard LEP Template. In preparing DLEP 2013, the Council has attempted to maintain the existing planning provisions from previous LEP's into the mandatory format of the Standard LEP Template. In developing DLEP 2013 a set of principles were developed and accordingly, these principles have been applied to items deferred from that draft plan.

It should be noted that the Standard LEP Instrument for the Blue Mountains, as revised in response to public submissions and submitted to the Department, is now being referred to as "DLEP 2015", unless specifically referring to an action taken to the then DLEP 2013 in which case it will be referred to as such.

The principles used for preparing the planning response to the deferred matters are noted below:

- Principle 1: Apply the same planning approach across the LGA.
 The first principle to producing DLEP 2015 was to create a consistent planning framework across the City that achieves ensure a balance between protecting the environment and permitting appropriate development was being applied in the same manner across the whole of the LGA.
- Principle 2: Use the Standard LEP Template format when possible

 The next principle was to maintain the approach developed in the existing planning instruments as much as possible through conversion, using the Standard LEP Template format. In a number of instances this was readily achieved, such as in matters of dictionary definitions.
- Principle 3: Use 'best-fit' to achieve current planning results
 In some instances the planning tools available in the Standard LEP Template format have no ready equivalent in either LEP 2005 or LEP 1991. In these cases, a 'best-fit' approach was applied to achieve the same result by different means.
- Principle 4: Introduce new policy only when appropriate

 There are many differences in planning structure and format between the existing LEPs in the Blue Mountains and the Standard LEP Template. Numerous instances require technical planning solutions to achieve the same planning result. A proper understanding of these planning approaches would be unnecessarily complicated by introducing numerous new policy outcomes at the same time. However, some areas of new policy that achieve improved outcomes have been included in DLEP 2013 for community consideration.

Council undertook extensive public exhibition of then DLEP 2013 from 4 December 2013 until 5 March 2014. The public consultation and exhibition exceeded the requirements of the Gateway Determination and the community was engaged in the process. Council received 595 submissions which raised just under 5,000 individual matters. A series of seven Extraordinary Meetings of the Council were held to consider matters raised in submissions from the community and public authorities. The majority of the issues were resolved however a number were deferred from then DLEP 2013.

Council did not wish to delay the adoption of its Standard LEP Instrument until the deferred items were resolved. The Department of Planning and Environment had previously indicated they were unwilling to grant any more time for Council to complete the Standard LEP Instrument. The most efficient option to meet an agreed timeframe for submission of then DLEP 2013 was to defer those items out of the draft plan where there would be benefit from

further review and consultation and Council had resolved accordingly. This has resulted in Council preparing an draft amendment to the new LEP with the intention that it proceed concurrently through the LEP process and be finalised at, or shortly after, the new LEP is made.

In the majority of the cases, the sites were deferred to enable further review and allow additional consultation. The deferred sites retain their current LEP provisions until such time as they are transferred into DLEP 2015.

A post exhibition Planning Proposal was prepared and this was reported to the Ordinary Meeting of the Council of 11 November 2014. At that meeting the Council made the following resolution:

- "1. That Council adopts Draft Local Environmental Plan 2013 (DLEP 2013), including the written instrument, maps and amended planning proposal, all included as a separate hard copy enclosure to this report as amended through the review of submission process;
- 2. That Council refers DLEP 2013 including the written instrument, maps and amended planning proposal to the Minister for Planning requesting the making of the plan in accordance with the provisions of Section 59 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979;
- 6. That the Council defers those sites from DLEP 2013 as identified through the review of submission process as land to be deferred from DLEP 2013, included as a separate hard copy enclosure to this report, which is to include all land proposed to be zoned R6 Residential Character Conservation until such time as suitable provision is made to identify and retain the diverse built and landscape elements that contribute to the character and image of the Blue Mountains;"

[Minute No. 1204]

The Planning Proposal was forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment (the Department) in late November 2014 for review and finalisation.

The above properties have been reviewed and individual assessments are provided as separate enclosures to this report (Attachments 4 to 32). When appropriate, extracts from Council's maps have been included in the discussion of a matter. Attachment 1 of the report provides legends for all maps.

The land exhibited in then DLEP 2013 to be zoned R6 Residential Character Conservation zone, or as noted as such in the post exhibition Planning Propsoal, is not included in this amendment and will be considered as part of a separate process. Two sites being 111 Mort Street Katoomba and 20 Hazel Avenue Hazelbrook, have not been included in this amendment to allow consultations to be conducted with the owner, Sydney Water. These parcels will be the subject of a separate amendment to DLEP 2015 in the future.

Planning Proposal

The process to include the deferred items into DLEP 2015 prescribes that Council prepare a Planning Proposal. The Planning Proposal for Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 (Attachment 3) has been prepared in accordance with the Departments publication "A Guide to Preparing Planning Proposals".

The processing of Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 is the same process that applies to any LEP and the main stages in the process are:

- 1. Planning Proposal is prepared in accordance with the Department's requirements.
- 2. The Council reviews the Planning Proposal.
- 3. If the Council agrees to support the proposal, the Planning Proposal is forwarded to the Department for assessment.
- 4. The Planning Proposal is reviewed by the Department's LEP Review panel.
- A Gateway determination is made and Council is advised of the determination and any conditions.
- Council processes the proposal in accordance with the Gateway determination which includes notification and public consultation.
- Any comments received during the exhibition period are considered and the proposal is re-assessed.
- 8. A report is prepared for the Council to consider the issues raised in the submissions, recommendations are made and a final Planning Proposal is prepared.
- 9. If the Council agrees to support the final Planning Proposal this is forwarded to the Department for final review and for the Minster to make the plan.

Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 is currently at Step 2 above.

Each Planning Proposal is for a new, or amending LEP. The only means of resolving the deferred items is to create a new, amending Planning Proposal, which is to be titled Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015. It is anticipated that as this is an amending Planning Proposal, the processing of Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 can be streamlined by the Department.

Planning Proposal content

The Planning Proposal is to be prepared in the prescribed manner. Key points are noted below.

Part 1: Objectives or Intended Outcomes

This part includes a statement of the objectives and intended outcomes of the proposed instrument and notes that the key principles applied to guide the development DLEP 2015 have also been applied to the Planning Proposal for Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015.

Part 2: Explanation of Provisions

This part contains an explanation of what the Planning Proposal is seeking to achieve which in this instance is to transfer land deferred from then DLEP 2013 into the Standard LEP Instrument for the Blue Mountains. Individual review and assessments for each of the sites deferred provide the required information.

Part 3: Justification

This part provides the justification for the Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 Planning Proposal.

Part 4: Mapping

Part 4 requires mapping of the sites and proposed mapped provisions. In this instance, the maps have been provided on the individual site reviews.

Part 5: Community Consultation

This part outlines the proposed community consultation. More information on community consultation is provided below.

Part 6: Project Timeline

This part shows an expected project timeline and key dates include:

- Community consultation May-June 2015
- Report back to Council August 2015
- Return the Planning Proposal back to the Department August-September 2015
- Plan is notified November 2015.

Communications strategy

All property owners of the above deferred sites have been notified in writing of the deferral and have been advised of this meeting. In addition, any submitters on the above deferred sites during the public exhibition of then DLEP 2013 have also been notified in writing. In addition, a Public Notice was placed within the 'Communicator' section of the Gazette on 18 March 2015 and is repeated on 25 March 2015. Council's website will also be updated accordingly.

Council proposes to undertake community and agency consultation in the following manner once a Gateway determination for Planning Proposal for Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 is received:

- Inform all landowners affected by the Planning Proposal for Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 in writing prior to the commencement of the exhibition period.
- Inform any previous submitters to land affected by the Planning Proposal for Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 in writing prior to the commencement of the exhibition period.
- Publicly exhibit the Planning Proposal for Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 for a period of 28 days.
- Place an advertisement in the local newspaper prior to commencement of the exhibition noting the exhibition period, where additional information can be obtained and how to make a submission.
- Provide information about the Planning Proposal and exhibition on the Council's website for the duration of the public exhibition period.
- Consult with agencies as required by the Gateway determination

A Council Report will then be prepared providing an assessment of any submissions received. All submitters during the formal public exhibition period will be notified of the meeting and can address the Council before a decision is made.

Financial implications for the Council

The resources required to complete this work including staff time and costs associated community consultation and finalization of the plan amendment are within budget.

Legal and risk management issues for the Council

Adoption of the recommendations of this report will commence the process of moving the deferred land into the principal LEP based on the Standard LEP Template which has been prepared in response to directions from the State Government.

As noted above, the Council's position in preparing DLEP 2015 has been to retain the planning framework embodied by LEP 2005 and LEP 1991. Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 has continued the application of these same principles.

Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 may require changes to clauses or provisions contained within the written DLEP 2015 document and these will be prepared in keeping with legal drafting principles.

External consultation

Council contacted State agencies who are land owners of deferred land. Comments received have been included in the assessment of the land. Consultation will be undertaken as required by the Gateway determination.

Conclusion

The Standard LEP Instrument (DLEP 2015) is considered to provide an appropriate framework in which to manage land use and development within the Blue Mountains and having all the land within the Blue Mountains LGA contained within the one LEP is the most desirable outcome. This report is seeking the Council's support to transfer a number of parcels of land that were deferred from the recent DLEP process into the DLEP 2015.

The principal recommendations of this report is that the Council adopt the individual recommendations for the sites deferred from DLEP 2015 and that the Council resolve to forward the Planning Proposal for Draft Amendment 1 to DLEP 2015 to the Department of Planning and Environment and request a Gateway review.


