The Director General or his delegate agree that the inconsistencies with Section 117 Directions 1.2 Rural Zones, 1.5 Rural Lands and 4.3 Flood Prone Lands is justified as of minor significance. 5. An Authorisation to exercise delegation to make the plan be issued to the council for this planning proposal. The reasons for the conditions to the Gateway Determination are as follows: Supporting Reasons 1. The inconsistencies of the proposal with the S117 Directions are of minor significance. 2. The proposed development of the land will result in a net community benefit; and 3. Council has determined that the use of the site as a caravan park is strategically justified.
