Please find enclosed Auburn City Council's Planning Proposal (our reference PP-3/2014) relating to land bounded by Mark, James, East and Railway Streets, Lidcombe, referred to as the Marsden Street Precinct, Lidcombe. The Planning Proposal seeks an amendment to the *Auburn Local Environmental Plan 2010* (ALEP) maps to rezone certain land within the precinct from IN2 Light Industrial and R4 High density residential to B4 Mixed Use and RE1 Public Recreation. It also seeks to amend the Lot Size, Height of Building (height), Floor Space Ratio (FSR) and Land Reservation Acquisition controls in line with the proposed rezoning.
