Proposal Summary :	The planning proposal is the first round of amendments of the Coffs Harbour Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2013 since its commencement on 27th September 2013.
	The content of the planning proposal consists of 25 'housekeeping' issues - additional uses, minor rezonings, alterations to minimum lot sizes, correcting descriptions of heritage items, new clause for temporary events and minor alterations to existing clauses.
