## JRPP Advice and Justification for Recommendation:

- 1. The Panel has considered the Department of Planning and Infrastructure's briefing note, as well as the views of the Council and of the proponent and has visited the site.
- 2. The Panel has been briefed by the Planning and Infrastructure Western Region Team, Orange City Council and the Applicant.
- 3. The Panel considered that, notwithstanding the current R1 Zone on the site, amenity impacts associated with recent development approvals and proposed road intersection upgrades adjacent to the site, are likely to hinder the site's development for residential uses. Consideration of alternative uses, appropriate to the site's context, is warranted.

- 4. Should the planning proposal proceed through the LEP Gateway, consideration should be given to amending the zoning and development controls applying to the site, in preference to amending the Additional Permitted Uses Schedule to the LEP.
- 5. The Panel recommends that Council be encouraged to undertake a strategic review of the North Orange Local Centre with regard to its role in the Orange centres hierarchy, traffic and access issues and associated land use zoning and development controls.
- 6. The Panel is of the unanimous view that there is strategic merit in the Planning Proposal being submitted for determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act*, 1979.
