Council, at its Meeting held on 17 July 2012, resolved to support a planning proposal over the above mentioned land and to refer it to the Planning Gateway.

The delay in referring this planning proposal to you has arisen due to Council waiting on a revised planning proposal from the applicants, amended to be consistent with Council's resolution, and the submission of the required political gifts and donations declarations. These have now been received.

Council has resolved to support the planning proposal on the basis of substantial environmental benefits that it will provide, as detailed in the planning proposal document. Furthermore, it will help facilitate the achievement of the north-south biodiversity corridor identified in the adopted Maclean Urban Catchment Local Growth Management Strategy 2011 (refer to Illustration 3.1 of that Strategy, copy attached) and Clarence Valley Council Biodiversity Management Strategy 2010 (refer Figure 2, copy attached). Council is of the view that these provide a substantial public and environment benefit and are a strong basis for the planning proposal being exhibited for public comment. Council is of the view that the proposal is consistent with the intended outcomes of the Mid North Coast Regional Strategy 2009, or if any inconsistency is identified, that they are justifiable on the basis of the public and environmental benefit.
