Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_LISMO_003_00): to correct cadastral errors and update cadastral information within Lismore LEP 2012.

I, the Executive Director, Rural and Regional Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Lismore Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to correct cadastral errors and amend the LEP maps to reflect the NSW Land and Property Information updated cadastral information for land at Clunes and East Lismore should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- No community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the 1. Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act").
- No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act. 2.

- The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 3 months from the week following the date 4. of the Gateway determination.
