Lismore LEP 2012 - General Amendments

Proposal Summary :

The purpose of the Planning Proposal is to make the following general 'housekeeping' amendments to Lismore LEP 2012:

* undertake various minor amendments to the Land Zoning, Lot Size Map, Height of Buildings and Heritage maps;

* update Schedule 5 Environmental Heritage;

* permit hardware and building supplies in Zone RU5 Village with development consent,

* permit vehicle repair stations in Zone B1 Neighbourhood Centre, B2 Local Centre and B3

Commercial Core with development consent;

* require development consent for home-based childcare in certain zones;

* refine clause 4.2C 'Erection of dual occupancies (detached) in zone RU1' to emphasize the protection of primary production potential of the land; and

* refine clause 4.2D 'Exceptions to minimum subdivision lot size for lot boundary adjustments in zone RU1' to cater for the non-urban zone combinations that occur in rural areas.

1. Council is to consult with the NSW Rural Fire Service as per the requirements of s117 Determination: Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection and amend the planning proposal, if

necessary to take into consideration any comments made prior to undertaking community consultation.

- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Act as follows:
- (a) the planning proposal and must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days;
- (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013); and
- (c) Any mapping material must meet the specifications in the current Standard Technical Requirements for Spatial Datasets and Maps (Department of Planning and Environment 2015).
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
- **Civil Aviation Air Authority**
- **NSW Office of Environment and Heritage**
- **Australian Rail Track Corporation**

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

	The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
