Planning proposal to amend Orange Local Environmental Plan 2011

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 22 May 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal (Amendment No. 3) to rezone land at 12 Astill Drive and 230 Phillip Street, Orange from RE1 Public Recreation to IN1 General Industrial and to reclassify land at 230 Phillip Street and 154 Lone Pine Avenue, Orange from 'community' to 'operational' land.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

In relation to S117 Direction 6.2 Reserving Land for Public Purposes, I have agreed to the reduction of land for public purposes on the basis of the lands surrounding uses or its reduced potential as public open space due to its separation from residential development. No further approval is required in relation to this Direction.

Council is reminded of its obligations for undertaking a public hearing in relation to the proposed reclassification of land in accordance with the department's practice note *PN09-003, Classification and reclassification of public land through a local environmental plan.*

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_ORANG_004_00): to reclassify and rezone land at Orange.

I, the Executive Director, Rural and Regional Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Orange Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2011 to rezone land at 12 Astill Drive and 230 Phillip Street, Orange from RE1 Public Recreation to IN1 General Industrial and to reclassify land at 230 Phillip Street and 154 Lone Pine Avenue, Orange from 'community' to 'operational' land should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to ensure the planning proposal addresses the Director-General's requirements relating to the reclassification of public land consistent with section 5.5.4 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs*.
- 2. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the planning proposal to include existing and proposed land zoning maps, which are at an appropriate scale and clearly identify the subject site.
- 3. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)*.
- 4. Consultation is required with Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act. RMS is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.
- 5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. However, a public hearing is required to be held into the matter in accordance with the department's practice note PN09-003, as the planning proposal involves a reclassification of land from community to operational.
- 6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
