Planning Proposal to amend Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011 (Amendment 7) (PP_2015_WENTW_001_00) to remove 3 local heritage items from Schedule 5 Environmental Heritage

I am writing in response to your Council's email dated 4 February 2015 requesting a Gateway determination in respect of the planning proposal to amend the Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011 (LEP) to remove three local heritage items from Schedule 5 Environmental Heritage.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination (Attachment 1).

I have also agreed the planning proposal's inconsistency with section 117 Direction 2.3 – Heritage Conservation is of minor significance. No further approval is required in relation to this Direction.

The Minister has delegated plan making powers to Councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of the planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan (Attachment 2).

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office (parliamentary.counsel@pco.nsw.gov.au) 10 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment (westerregion@planning.nsw.gov.au) for administrative purposes.

State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete the LEP's by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 if the time frames outlined in the determination are not met.

In accordance with "A guide for the preparation of local environmental plans" Attachment 5 - Delegated plan making reporting template (Attachment 3) is enclosed for Council's information. Tabe 2 of the attachment is to be completed and included in Council's section 59 submission and forwarded to the westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au when requesting the planning proposal to be finalised.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2015_WENTW_001_00): to amend the Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011 to remove 3 local heritage items from Schedule 5 Environmental Heritage...

I, the General Manager, Western Region at Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 to amend the Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011 to remove 3 local heritage items from Schedule 5 Environmental Heritage, should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental 1. Planning and Assessment Act 1979 as follows:
 - the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; (a)
 - the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Planning & Infrastructure 2013).
- Consultation is required with the NSW Office of Environment and Heritage under Section 2. 56(2)(d) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979. The NSW Office of Environment and Heritage is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.
- A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under 3. section 56(2)(e) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- Prior to submission of the planning proposal under section 59 of the Environmental 4. Planning and Assessment Act 1979, LEP maps must be prepared and be compliant with the Department's 'Standard Technical Requirements for LEP Maps'.
- The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the 5. date of the Gateway determination.
