MASTER PLAN

STAGE ONE: 2014

1. Talong Street parking and main entry plaza
2. Provide connection paths to the local neighbourhood with formal planting to enhance the sense of arrival
3. Vibrant central park picnic facilities providing provisions for playground and open space. Playground accessible from Bradwood Drive and Ulladulla Street. Proposed location also takes opportunity of the existing slope for future play elements
4. Fitness stations and 1/2 court basketball, located adjacent picnic facilities and playgrounds
5. Ridge top flat level area good for open play and bar games
7. Gravel path. Good opportunity to connect and unite the site. Opportunity for bike riding and walking with a firm cutout and 100m distance markers to enable tracking of fitness workouts
9. Perimeter buffer planting adjacent to private lots, to improve the park's spatial character and enhance privacy of adjacent residents. Provide open and permeable gardens with lots shrubs and grasses for visual surveillance
11. Proposed off road dog park
13. Recreational nodes with optimum views over the park and town
15. Proposed street trees and parking along Wagga Street
16. Connection path to Bradwood Drive south and adjacent Blue Hills Village Park and Preston shopping village

FUTURE STAGES

6. Proposed off street parking on Ulladulla Street. Provides connection to park plaza and dog park
8. Existing remnant Cumberland Plain Woodland to be left in part of the Future Environmental Program
10. Provide a semi formal base, no trees. Started out with low shrubs and grasses
12. Existing dam to be left as part of the Future Environmental Program
14. Low perimeter planting with electrical equipment
17. Polychrome sand water-scoops and sails
18. Gravel Path
19. Provide connection paths to local neighbourhood
