Planning proposal to amend Burwood Local Environmental Plan 2012

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 5 April 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to rezone part of the Strathfield Sports Club site located on land between Morwick and Lyons Streets, Strathfield from RE2 Private Recreation to B4 Mixed Use and apply a maximum floor space ratio of 3:1, maximum height of buildings of 30m and a minimum lot size of 500sqm to the subject land.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

It is noted that a Voluntary Planning Agreement (VPA) will be prepared for the dedication of land and for the construction of a new road linking Morwick and Lyons Streets, Strathfeild. Council is encouraged to exhibit the VPA with the planning proposal to ensure that the public is adequately informed about the land dedication and the construction of a new road.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_BURWO_001_00): to rezone part of the Strathfield Sports Club site and amend the development standards applying to the land.

I, the Acting Executive Director, Metropolitan Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Burwood Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to rezone part of the Strathfield Sports Club site located on land between Morwick and Lyons Streets, Strathfield from RE2 Private Recreation to B4 Mixed Use and apply a maximum floor space ratio of 3:1, maximum height of buildings of 30m and a minimum lot size of 500sqm to the subject land should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to consult with Sydney Water to determine the extent of potential flooding on the site and, if required, is to prepare a flood study. Following consultation with Sydney Water the planning proposal is to be updated to address the proposals consistency or to justify any inconsistency with S117 Direction 4.3 Flood Prone Land.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)*.
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act, service providers and/or to demonstrate consistency with relevant S117 Directions:
 - Sydney Water
 - Telstra
 - Endeavour Energy
 - Jemena
 - Roads and Maritime Services (concerning the proposed dedication of a new road)

Each public authority or service provider is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).



5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **9 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
