It housed the nuns serving the district people, and was a centre for music tuition for many years. Originally this was the site of the first convent building, a weatherboard structure erected with money supplied by Denis Buckley, a single, devout Irishman who was a successful gold miner. The present convent building was ereceted in 1955 - 56, and was for many years occupied by the Sisters of St. Joseph. Currently (2006), the use of the building is being discussed, with the likelihood that it will become an integral part of the adjoining St. Anne's School, as the nuns who once occupied it have either died, moved away, or currently (2006), are accommodated elsewhere.
