In 1931, the Great Depression meant that the Show may have had to be abandoned, but determined, the the locals went ahead with it, albeit, a more modest event. However, the 1935 Show, with the Depression almost over, was celebrated as the Jubilee Show, a grand event, recalling 50 years of agriculural achievement in the area.
