**Statement of significance:** Contributing. Over the years has housed the Baptist Pastor and his family and has served also as a personal meeting and consulting place for members of the community.

**Historical notes of provenance:** The Baptist Manse was built at the same time as the Church in 1909. As the main driving force at the time was Mr. John Baker, who already occupied 1 Victoria Street, it appears significant that the manse was built next door to him. The first minister to occupy the Manse, was the Rev. Tranter, who was the first Baptist Minister to operate out of Temora, earlier work being done from Beaconsfield and Barmedman. Currently (2006) with the Gil Venz from Aria Park carryng on the ministerial duties, the house is rented.
