significance: Historical notes	A most significant site for the Trungley Hall community, being the centre of the German Lutheran congregation that came from South Australia, Victoria and Southern NSW in the 1890's and early 1900's. The original building on this site was of pine and pug construction with sod walls, later covered in weatherboard. It had a high single-pitched iron roof, and included a choir loft. A skillion extension was added to one side. It was used as a church from 1893 until the new one built on the southern side of the road in 1911. It was used continuously as a Lutheran Day School from 1906 until 1948, despite two World Wars. The building was demolished prior to 1949 when a new hall was created by tranferring a building from Burilyang to south of the church.
