3. North Silverdale (PP_2013_WOLLY_005_00)

Current Status:

In late 2014 Council resolved to request an alteration to the Gateway Determination to request changes to zoning types, amendments to studies required and also requested the deletion of the requirement for an odour study in lieu of an odour buffer around a nearby poultry farm. An altered gateway was issued by the Department in June, 2015 in respect of these matters.

Following the receipt of the alteration to the Gateway Determination, Council provided advice to the proponent including suggested changes to comply with the altered Gateway. Council also requested updated specialist studies to address concerns that had previously been raised by Council and various state government departments. These amended Specialist Studies are required prior to proceeding to public exhibition. These studies are currently being amended before being submitted to Council. Council has also been working with the proponent and OEH in an attempt to resolve vegetation issues associated with the proposal.

The proponent has advised Council that these updated specialist studies should be received by the end of the year. Council is also liaising with the proponent regarding the possibility of the placement of a park or reserve in the middle of the site for future community use.

Current Status:

Specialist Studies were submitted to Council in respect of the Planning Proposal in December, 2016. Feedback was provided by internal Council staff and state government agencies in March/April, 2016. Council's internal property panel also resolved in March, 2016 not to accept the dedication of the proposed E2 zoned land which the proponent had requested.

In June, 2016 detailed advice was provided to the proponent outlining the additional material that needs to be included in the Flora and Fauna Assessment. The advice included suggested amendments to the zone layout and minimum lot size which may overcome some of the outstanding vegetation issues on the site and appropriate options for the proposed E2 lands on the site. Upon receipt of the amended Specialist Studies it is anticipated that the proposal would progress to public exhibition.

The planning proposal is on hold in light of recent announcements by the Department related to a shift to a digital planning system in NSW. These changes will affect the way spatial data is managed and published, particularly the standard technical requirements for spatial data accompanying planning proposals with a reduced reliance on PDF maps.

Completing the LEP amendment requires a significant amount of GIS/Mapping staff resources to amend 37 Heritage Maps. A shift to a digital planning system may remove the need to change the heritage map projections.

This planning proposal will remain on hold until we can better understand the impact of the proposed changes and to establish whether a planning proposal is still the best means of achieving the planning proposal objectives.
