Planning proposal to amend Guyra Local Environmental Plan 2012

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 31 May 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to reclassify the Kolora Aged Care Hostel at 11-27 Lochaber Crescent, Guyra from 'community' to 'operational' land.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

Council is reminded of its obligations for undertaking a public hearing in relation to the proposed reclassification of land in accordance with the department's practice note *PN09-003*, *Classification and reclassification of public land through a local environmental plan*.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has asked not to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal to avoid any conflict of interest because Council owns the subject land. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan as the proposal is considered to be a matter of local significance. Council should contact the regional office of the department should it require assistance in relation to the exercise of its delegation.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 6 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_GUYRA_001_00): to reclassify the Kolora Aged Care Hostel at Guyra from 'community' to 'operational' land.

I the Executive Director, Rural and Regional Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Guyra Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to reclassify the Kolora Aged Care Hostel at 11-27 Lochaber Crescent, Guyra from 'community' to 'operational' land should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the project timeline within the 1... planning proposal to reflect that Council has been issued with plan making delegation for this planning proposal. Council is to update the planning proposal to reference the correct property description for the subject land, being Lot 131 DP 612522 instead of Lot 13 DP 612522.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; (a)
 - the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public (b) exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).
- 3. No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act.
- A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter under section 56(2)(e) of the 4 EP&A Act. However, a public hearing is required to be held into the matter in accordance with the department's practice note PN09-003, as the planning proposal involves a reclassification of land from community to operational.
- The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 6 months from the week following the date 5. of the Gateway determination.
