Proposal Summary :	This Planning Proposal amends Byron LEP 2014 to - insert additional permissible tourism-related uses in the land use tables for RU1 Primary Production, RU2 Rural Landscape and B4 Mixed Use zones; - extends permissibility of bed and breakfast establishments from a maximum 3 bedroom dwelling to a maximum 5 bedroom dwelling; and - schedule single-bedroom bed and breakfasts as exempt development.

Council consult with the NSW Department of Primary Industries -Agriculture; the Office of Environment and Heritage; and the Commissioner of the NSW Rural Fire Services; A delegate of the Secretary agree that inconsistencies of the proposal with S117 Directions 1.1, 1.5, 4.1 and 4.3 are justified in accordance with the terms of the directions. A delegate of the Secretary note that inconsistency with section 117 direction 4.4 may be resolved following consultation with the Rural Fire Service; The planning proposal is to be completed within 12 months.
