Planning Proposal PP_2011_WAGGA_002_00 – Gateway Determination Alteration

I refer to your letter of 29 August 2014 seeking an amendment to Planning Proposal PP_2011_WAGGA_002_00 to rectify a number of anomalies and errors with local heritage items in Schedule 5 and the Heritage Map of Wagga Wagga Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2010.

I have determined as the delegate of the Minister for Planning, and in accordance with section 56(7) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979, to amend the Gateway determination dated 21 November 2011 (as amended 15 August 2014) for Planning Proposal PP_2011_WAGGA_002_00. Please find attached an alteration to the Gateway determination for this revised planning proposal.

Please note that condition 6 of the Gateway Determination requires Council to revise the planning proposal to identify the heritage items to be amended on the Heritage Map prior to community consultation.

Council will be required to undertake community consultation for the revised planning proposal comprising a minimum exhibition period of 28 days. This will include consultation with relevant State agencies.

Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal within four weeks from the week following this revised determination. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's office six weeks prior to the projected publication date.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

Alteration of Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2011_WAGGA_002_00)

I, Acting General Manager, Southern Region, at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(7) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act")* to alter the Gateway Determination dated 21 November 2011 (as since altered) for the proposed amendment to the Wagga Wagga Local Environmental Plan 2010 by:

1. Changing the description of the Planning Proposal

From "to correct a number of anomalies with 91 heritage items, should proceed subject to the following conditions:"

to "to correct a number of anomalies with heritage items, as detailed in the planning proposal dated 29 August 2014, should proceed subject to the following conditions:"

2. new clause 6

"6. The revised planning proposal must clearly identify all of the heritage items that are to be amended by the revised Heritage Map prior to commencing community consultation."

3. new clause 7

"7. Community consultation is required for the revised planning proposal under sections 56 (2) (c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:

- (a) the revised planning proposal must be made publicly available for 28 days; and
- (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of 'A guide to preparing local environmental plans' (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013).
- 4. new clause 8

"8. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act:

• Heritage Division, Office of Environment and Heritage

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the revised planning proposal and any relevant supporting material. Each public authority is to be given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal, or to indicate they will require additional time to comment on the proposal. Public authorities may request additional information or additional matters to be addressed in the planning proposal.

5. new clause 9

"9. Council is to consult with the Commissioner of the NSW Rural Fire Service on the revised planning proposal prior to undertaking community consultation and take into account any comments made as per the requirements of S117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection."
