# **DRAFT KYOGLE LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN - HERITAGE PROVISIONS**

Application is herein made to convert Kyogle Council's draft Local Environmental Plan 18 from the pre-Gateway plan making process to a Planning Proposal under the amended provisions of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979. This is to provide a contingency plan in the event that the LEP is not published by the expiration period established by the 1 July 2009 amendments to the Act.

A section 65(1) certification of draft LEP 18 (Heritage Provisions) was issued by the Director General on 16 February 2007 and revised on 28 August 2009. Due to the establishment of new procedures for the preparation of local environmental plans, draft LEP 18 may only be made under the pre-Gateway plan making provisions until 1 July 2010. This may not be achievable.

Currently LEP 18 has undergone public advertising following the resolution of Kyogle Council at its Ordinary Meeting held 15 February 2010 to adopt the draft Kyogle Local Government Area Heritage Review 2009 and draft Local Environmental Plan 18 (Heritage Provisions) for the purpose of public exhibition. This exhibition period spanned 32 days from 22 March 2010 until the close of business on 22 April 2010. Submissions are being collated and a report to the elected Council is anticipated on 17 May 2010.

The aims of LEP 18 are described in clause 1.2 of the draft document, which is attached for your information and purposes. The LEP endeavours to provide planning controls for a number of environmental studies undertaken in the Kyogle Local Government Area pertaining to non-Indigenous heritage, including the:

- Godden Mackay Kyogle Shire Heritage Study, Volume 1
- Godden Mackay Kyogle Shire Heritage Study, Volume 2
- > Kyogle Local Government Area Heritage Review 2009
- Kyogle Local Government Area State Heritage Inventory Database

It also seeks to bring to fruition the objectives of Division 3 Heritage of the North Coast Regional Environmental Plan, section 117 Direction 2.3 Heritage Conservation, and Section 117 Direction 5.1 Implementation of Regional Strategies (the Far North Coast Regional Strategy describes on page 20 that "Councils and the Department of Planning will review the scope and quality of the existing statutory lists of heritage items and ensure that all places of significance are included in the heritage schedules of local

environmental plans." Kyogle Council currently does not have an existing statutory list although places of significance have been documented through joint funding from the Heritage Branch).

There is inherently merit in the proposed LEP 18 being progressed to the point of publication and the proposal to convert the process to a Planning Proposal is deemed to be insurance that the aims of the plan will be achieved.

For the purposes of completeness, you will also find enclosed draft maps displayed by Council during the advertising period of LEP 18 and the Kyogle Local Government Area Heritage Review 2009. In order to finalise these maps in accordance with the Standard Technical requirements for LEP maps, the electronic scale will need to be corrected, the grey borders established, and the grid scale revised to better suit the villages of the Kyogle Local Government Area.

Kyogle Council is striving to provide the necessary statutory and administrative framework that can foster the retention and conservation of identified heritage items over the Local Government Area. Subsequent to this Council humbly requests that the pre-Gateway process for LEP 18 be amended to a Planning Proposal under the new Part 3 of the Act.

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# **Kyogle Local Environmental Plan 18**

# Part 1 Preliminary

#### 1.1 Name of Plan

This Plan is Kyogle Local Environmental Plan 18.

# 1.2 Aims of Plan

- (1) This Plan aims to make local environmental planning provisions for heritage conservation on land within the Kyogle Council local government area in a prescribed standard form.
- (2) The particular aims of this Plan are as follows:
  - (a) to give effect to the Kyogle Shire Heritage Study 1996 and the Kyogle Heritage Review 2009;
  - (b) to integrate heritage conservation into planning and development control processes;
  - (c) to conserve the environmental heritage of the Kyogle Council local government area; and
  - (d) to encourage an appreciation of the heritage of the Kyogle Council local government area.

#### 1.3 Land to which Plan applies

This Plan applies to the land identified on the Land Application Map.

# 1.4 Definitions

The Dictionary at the end of this Plan defines words and expressions for the purposes of this Plan.

#### 1.5 Notes

Notes in this Plan are provided for guidance and do not form part of this Plan.

#### 1.6 Consent authority

The consent authority for the purposes of this Plan is (subject to the Act) the Kyogle Council.

# 1.7 Maps

- (1) A reference in this Plan to a named map adopted by this Plan is a reference to a map by that name:
  - (a) approved by the Minister when the map is adopted, and
  - (b) as amended or replaced from time to time by maps declared by environmental planning instruments to amend or replace that map, and approved by the Minister when the instruments are made.
- (2) Any 2 or more named maps may be combined into a single map. In that case, a reference in this Plan to any such named map is a reference to the relevant part or aspect of the single map.
- (3) Any such maps are to be kept and made available for public access in accordance with arrangements approved by the Minister.
- (4) For the purposes of this Plan, a map may be in, and may be kept and made available in, electronic or paper form, or both.

**Note.** The maps adopted by this Plan are to be made available on the official NSW legislation website in connection with this Plan. Requirements relating to the maps are set out in the documents entitled *Standard technical requirements for LEP maps* and *Standard requirements for LEP GIS data* which are available on the Department of Planning's website.

### 1.8 Repeal of other local planning instruments applying to land

- This plan amends Interim Development Order No. 1 Shire of Kyogle and Interim Development Order No. 1 - Shire of Terania by inserting after Clause 22(c) the Clause 22(d).
- (2) Clause 22(d) shall read "the consent authority is satisfied that the development is consistent with the objectives and provisions of Kyogle Local Environmental Plan 18."

# 1.9 Application of SEPPs and REPs

(1) This Plan is subject to the provisions of any State environmental planning policy and any regional environmental plan that prevail over this Plan as provided by section 36 of the Act.

**Note.** Section 36 of the Act generally provides that SEPPs prevail over REPs and LEPs and that REPs prevail over LEPs. However, a LEP may (by an additional provision included in the Plan) displace or amend a SEPP or REP to deal specifically with the relationship between this Plan and the SEPP or REP.

# Part 2 Heritage provisions

#### 2.1 Heritage conservation

Note. Heritage items, heritage conservation areas and archaeological sites (if any) are shown on the Heritage Map. The location and nature of any such item, area or site is also described in Schedule 1.

**Note.** Where Aboriginal heritage is not listed in Schedule 1, section 79C of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* will require that matters involving Aboriginal heritage significance are taken into consideration in determining a development application.

#### (1) Objectives

The objectives of this clause are:

- (a) to conserve the environmental heritage of Kyogle local government area, and
- (b) to conserve the heritage significance of heritage items and heritage conservation areas including associated fabric, settings and views, and
- (c) to conserve archaeological sites, and
- (d) to conserve places of Aboriginal heritage significance.

#### (2) Requirement for consent

- Development consent is required for any of the following:
- (a) demolishing or moving a heritage item or a building, work, relic or tree within a heritage conservation area,
- (b) altering a heritage item or a building, work, relic, tree or place within a heritage conservation area, including (in the case of a building) making changes to the detail, fabric, finish or appearance of its exterior,
- (c) altering a heritage item that is a building by making structural changes to its interior,
- (d) disturbing or excavating an archaeological site while knowing, or having reasonable cause to suspect, that the disturbance or excavation will or is likely to result in a relic being discovered, exposed, moved, damaged or destroyed,
- (e) erecting a building on land on which a heritage item is located or that is within a heritage conservation area,
- (g) subdividing land on which a heritage item is located or that is within a heritage conservation area.

#### (3) When consent not required

- However, consent under this clause is not required if:
- (a) the applicant has notified the consent authority of the proposed development and the consent authority has advised the applicant in writing before any work is carried out that it is satisfied that the proposed development:
  - (i) is of a minor nature, or is for the maintenance of the heritage item, archaeological site, or a building, work, relic, tree or place within a heritage conservation area, and
  - (ii) would not adversely affect the significance of the heritage item, archaeological site or heritage conservation area, or
- (b) the development is in a cemetery or burial ground and the proposed development:
  - (i) is the creation of a new grave or monument, or excavation or disturbance of land for the purpose of conserving or repairing monuments or grave markers, and
  - (ii) would not cause disturbance to human remains, relics, Aboriginal objects in the form of grave goods, or to a place of Aboriginal heritage significance, or
- (c) the development is limited to the removal of a tree or other vegetation that the Council is satisfied is a risk to human life or property, or
- (d) the development is exempt development.

#### (4) Effect on heritage significance

The consent authority must, before granting consent under this clause, consider the effect of the proposed development on the heritage significance of the heritage item or heritage conservation area concerned. This subclause applies regardless of whether a heritage impact statement is prepared under subclause (5) or a heritage conservation management plan is submitted under subclause (6).

#### (5) Heritage impact assessment

The consent authority may, before granting consent to any development on land:

- (a) on which a heritage item is situated, or
- (b) within a heritage conservation area, or
- (c) within the vicinity of land referred to in paragraph (a) or (b),

require a heritage impact statement to be prepared that assesses the extent to which the carrying out of the proposed development would affect the heritage significance of the heritage item or heritage conservation area concerned.

#### (6) Heritage conservation management plans

The consent authority may require, after considering the significance of a heritage item and the extent of change proposed to it, the submission of a heritage conservation management plan before granting consent under this clause.

#### (7) Archaeological sites

The consent authority must, before granting consent under this clause to the carrying out of development on an archaeological site (other than land listed on the State Heritage Register or to which an interim heritage order under the <u>Heritage Act 1977</u> applies):

(a) notify the Heritage Council of its intention to grant consent, and

(b) take into consideration any response received from the Heritage Council within 28 days after the notice is sent.

#### (8) Places of Aboriginal heritage significance

The consent authority must, before granting consent under this clause to the carrying out of development in a place of Aboriginal heritage significance:

- (a) consider the effect of the proposed development on the heritage significance of the place and any Aboriginal object known or reasonably likely to be located at the place, and
- (b) notify the local Aboriginal communities (in such way as it thinks appropriate) about the application and take into consideration any response received within 28 days after the notice is sent.

#### (9) Demolition of item of State significance

The consent authority must, before granting consent for the demolition of a heritage item identified in Schedule 5 as being of State significance (other than an item listed on the State Heritage Register or to which an interim heritage order under the <u>Heritage Act</u> <u>1977</u> applies):

- (a) notify the Heritage Council about the application, and
- (b) take into consideration any response received from the Heritage Council within 28 days after the notice is sent.

#### (10) Conservation incentives

The consent authority may grant consent to development for any purpose of a building that is a heritage item, or of the land on which such a building is erected, even though development for that purpose would otherwise not be allowed by the interim development order or any development control plan, if the consent authority is satisfied that:

- (a) the conservation of the heritage item is facilitated by the granting of consent, and
- (b) the proposed development is in accordance with a heritage conservation management plan that has been approved by the consent authority, and
- (c) the consent to the proposed development would require that all necessary conservation work identified in the heritage conservation management plan is carried out, and
- (d) the proposed development would not adversely affect the heritage significance of the heritage item, including its setting, and

(e) the proposed development would not have any significant adverse effect on the amenity of the surrounding area.

# Dictionary

(Clause 1.4)

*Aboriginal object* means any deposit, object or other material evidence (not being a handicraft made for sale) relating to the Aboriginal habitation of an area of New South Wales, being habitation before or concurrent with (or both) the occupation of that area by persons of non-Aboriginal extraction, and includes Aboriginal remains.

archaeological site means an area of land:

- (a) shown on the Heritage Map as an archaeological site, and
- (b) the location and nature of which is described in Schedule 1, and
- (c) that contains one or more relics.

building has the same meaning as in the Act.

**Note.** The term is defined to include part of a building and any structure or part of a structure, but not including a manufactured home, a moveable dwelling or associated structure (or part of a manufactured home, moveable dwelling or associated structure).

*cemetery* means a building or place for the interment of deceased persons or their ashes.

Council means the Kyogle Council.

*curtilage*, in relation to a heritage item or conservation area, means the area of land (including land covered by water) surrounding a heritage item, a heritage conservation area, or building, work or place within a heritage conservation area, that contributes to its heritage significance.

*demolish*, in relation to a heritage item, or a building, work, relic or tree within a heritage conservation area, means wholly or partly destroy, dismantle or deface the heritage item or the building, work, relic or tree.

*excavation* means the removal of soil or rock, whether moved to another part of the same site or to another site, but does not include garden landscaping that does not significantly alter the shape, natural form or drainage of the land.

heritage conservation area means an area of land:

- (a) shown on the Heritage Map as a heritage conservation area or as a place of Aboriginal heritage significance, and
- (b) the location and nature of which is described in Schedule 1,

and includes any heritage items situated on or within that area.

*heritage conservation management plan* means a document prepared in accordance with guidelines prepared by the Department of Planning that documents the heritage significance of an item, place or heritage conservation area and identifies

conservation policies and management mechanisms that are appropriate to enable that significance to be retained.

heritage impact statement means a document consisting of:

- (a) a statement demonstrating the heritage significance of a heritage item, archaeological site, place of Aboriginal heritage significance or other heritage conservation area, and
- (b) an assessment of the impact that proposed development will have on that significance, and
- (c) proposals for measures to minimise that impact.

*heritage item* means a building, work, archaeological site, tree, place or Aboriginal object:

- (a) shown on the Heritage Map as a heritage item, and
- (b) the location and nature of which is described in Schedule 1, and
- (c) specified in an inventory of heritage items that is available at the office of the Council.

Heritage Map means the Kyogle Local Environmental Plan 18 Heritage Map.

*heritage significance* means historical, scientific, cultural, social, archaeological, architectural, natural or aesthetic value.

*Land Application Map* means the Kyogle Local Environmental Plan 18 Land Application Map.

*maintenance*, in relation to a heritage item or a building, work, archaeological site, tree or place within a heritage conservation area, means ongoing protective care. It does not include the removal or disturbance of existing fabric, alterations, such as carrying out extensions or additions, or the introduction of new materials or technology.

*place of Aboriginal heritage significance* means an area of land shown on the Heritage Map that is:

- (a) the site of one or more Aboriginal objects or a place that has the physical remains of pre-European occupation by, or is of contemporary significance to, the Aboriginal people. It can (but need not) include items and remnants of the occupation of the land by Aboriginal people, such as burial places, engraving sites, rock art, midden deposits, scarred and sacred trees and sharpening grooves, or
- (b) a natural Aboriginal sacred site or other sacred feature. It includes natural features such as creeks or mountains of long-standing cultural significance, as well as initiation, ceremonial or story places or areas of more contemporary cultural significance.

relic means any deposit, object or other material evidence of human habitation:

- (a) that relates to the settlement of the area of Kyogle, not being Aboriginal settlement, and
- (b) that is more than 50 years old, and
- (c) that is a fixture or is wholly or partly within the ground.

the Act means the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.
