Supporting Reasons

The Planning Proposal seeks to rezone Lot 5, DP 1048585, Burgmanns Lane, South Tamworth from RU4 Primary Production Small Lots to SP3 Tourist to facilitate the development of a new 1000m harness racing track and associated facilities including a clubhouse, marquee, stables and parade ring.

It is considered to be a significant development for Tamworth and is supported by Council's strategic planning work.

The Planning Proposal should proceed subject to the following conditions:

1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental

Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:

(a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Planning & Infrastructure 2013) and must be made publicly available for a minimum

of 14 days; and  (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Planning & Infrastructure 2013).
<ol> <li>Consultation is required with the NSW Roads and Maritime Services under section 56(2) (d) of the EP&amp;A Act. NSW Roads and Maritime Services is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.</li> </ol>
3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 6 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
