Planning proposal details:

PP_2013_WOLLY_008_00: To rezone land at The Oaks for residential purposes and amend the development standards applying to the land.

Planning proposal summary:

To rezone land at 780 and 790 Montpelier Drive, The Oaks from RU2 Rural Landscape to R2 Low Density Residential, amend the minimum lot size to 975sqm (or greater) and the maximum building height to 9m on the subject land and amend the Natural Resources Water Map.
