1 Name of Plan

This Plan is Murray Local Environmental Plan 2011 (Amendment No 11).

2 Commencement

Schedule 1 Additional permitted uses

Insert at the end of the Schedule:

2 Use of certain land within Crown Reserve R56146

- (1) This clause applies to land within Crown Reserve R56146 at Moama that is occupied by the mooring specified in commercial mooring licence CL 6224 and located opposite Lot 1, DP 903914, Forbes Street, Moama and Lots 3-5, section 58, DP 758686, Ward Street, Moama.
- (2) Development for the purpose of a restaurant is permitted with development consent.
