Planning proposal to amend Auburn LEP 2011 to correct minor mapping errors and anomalies in various locations across the local government area.

I am writing in response to your Council's letter requesting a Gateway Determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to amend the Auburn Local Environmental Plan 2011 to correct minor mapping errors and anomalies in various locations across the local government area.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway Determination.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 3 months of the week following the date of the Gateway Determination. Given that the amendment only involves the rectification of minor errors and anomalies, no community consultation is necessary. As it has been determined that this is a minor amendment, the Department will commence drafting the instrument immediately. The Regional Planning Team will remain your principal contact on this matter and will be able to provide advice on the progress of the draft LEP.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under s54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2011_AUBUR_004_00): to amend Auburn LEP 2010 to correct minor mapping errors and anomalies in various locations across the local government area.

I, the Director General, Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Auburn Local Environmental Plan 2010 to correct minor mapping errors and anomalies in various locations across the local government area should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. No community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act").
- 2. No consultation is required with State or Commonwealth public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act:
- 3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **3 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
