Gateway Determination :	1. Prior to the commencement of community consultation, the planning proposal is to be amended to include an updated timeline consistent with the community consultation and completion dates in Conditions 4 and 7.				
	2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Act as follows:				
	<ul> <li>(a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013) and must be made publicly available for a minimum of 14 days; and</li> <li>(b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2016).</li> </ul>				
	3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:				
	<ul> <li>(a) NSW Roads and Maritime Services</li> <li>(b) NSW Rural Fire Service</li> <li>(c) Office of Environment and Heritage</li> </ul>				
	Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.				
	4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).				
	5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
