Planning proposal to amend Wagga Wagga Local Environmental Plan 2010

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 3 November 2016 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land at Cartwrights Hill to R5 Large Lot Residential and RU1 Primary Production Zones.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination. I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the planning proposal is not inconsistent with the S117 Directions.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office six weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the Act if the timeframes outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_WAGGA_001_00): to rezone land amend lot sizes at Cartwrights Hill.

- I, the Acting Director Regions, Southern at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (the Act) that an amendment to the Wagga Wagga Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2010 to:
- a) rezone Lot 1 DP 572883, Lot 2 DP 612237 and Lot 10 DP 255059 to R5 Large Lot Residential Zone with a 1 ha minimum lot size; and
- b) rezone Lots 1-4 DP 700660 to RU1 Primary Production Zone with a 200 ha minimum lot size,

should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Amend the Explanation of Provisions section of the planning proposal prior to proceeding 1... to community consultation to reflect an appropriate amendment to the Land Application Map to remove the deferred matter status from the subject land.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2016).
- 3. No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the Act.
- 4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 5. The LEP maps shall be prepared in accordance with the Standard Technical Requirements for Spatial Datasets and Maps (Department of Planning and Environment, 2015).
- 6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the date of the Gateway determination.
