2016SYW068 – Hawkesbury - PP_2016_HAWKE_001_00 AT 1059A Grose Vale Rd, Kurrajong (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the material listed at item 4, and the material presented at meetings and matters observed at site inspections listed at item 5 in Schedule 1.

The Panel heard submissions, then closed the meeting, deliberated on the matter and formulated a resolution. As the relevant planning authority, the Panel determined that the proposed instrument, as described in Schedule 1, should be made. The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel endorses the release to the public of the submissions report and adopts the planning proposal.

The Panel requests:

- 1. The Department to prepare the Standard Instrument mapping for the proposal;
- 2. The Secretary to prepare a draft Local Environment Plan (LEP) under section 59(1) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (the Act), including consultation with the Panel on the wording of the LEP;
- 3. Request the delegate of the Greater Sydney Commission to make the LEP under section 59(2) of the Act.

The Panel agrees with the Department of Planning and Environment's comments in its assessment report of 15 March 2017. In addition, the Panel notes the position of the Roads and Maritime Services in its letters of 18 January 2017 and 7 December 2016 that is has no objections to this planning proposal but that it recommends a strategic traffic study be undertaken. The Panel notes the Council is undertaking such a study and strongly supports the Council's action in this regard.
