

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_RYDEC_003_00): to facilitate various amendments in draft Ryde LEP 2014.

I, the Director, Metropolitan Delivery at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (EP&A Act) that PP_2013_RYDEC_003_00 should proceed subject to the following conditions:

1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the EP&A Act as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)* and must be made publicly available for a minimum of **14** days;
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)*; and
2. A Parking and Traffic Model Study and Impact Assessment, undertaken by Council and Bunnings Group Ltd, should be publicly exhibited with the planning proposal.
3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act:
 - (a) Transport for NSW – Roads and Maritime Authority
 - (b) Sydney Water
 - (c) Office of Environment and Heritage (Heritage Office)
4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.

**Planning proposal to amend draft Ryde Local Environmental Plan 2014 at
2 College Street and 10 Monash Road, Gladesville**

I refer to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) in respect of the planning proposal to facilitate various amendments to draft Ryde LEP 2014 at 2 College Street and 10 Monash Road, Gladesville.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I agree that the planning proposal's inconsistency with s117 Direction 3.1 Residential Zones is of minor significance. No further approval is required in relation to this Direction.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.
