PLANNING PROPOSAL DRAFT KEMPSEY LEP 2013 AMENDMENT NO 25 - TO AMEND THE LAND ZONING MAP FOR LAND AT NEVILLE MORTON DRIVE, CRESCENT HEAD FROM RU2 - RURAL LANDSCAPE AND E2 - ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION TO R5-LARGE LOT RESIDENTIAL & REVISE THE LOT SIZE MAP FROM FORTY (40) TO ONE (1) HECTARE(S) - REQUEST FOR GATEWAY DETERMINATION

Reference is made to the above Planning Proposal.

On 26 June 2018 Council resolved:

- 1. That the planning proposal, which seeks to rezone approximately 12 hectares of land from RU2 - Rural Landscape and E2 - Environmental Conservation to R5 - Large Lot Residential at Lot 3 DP 1164661 Neville Morton Drive, Crescent Head, be submitted to the Minister for Planning for Gateway consideration pursuant to section 3.34 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.
- 2. That the Secretary of the Department of Planning and Environment be requested to issue Council with written authorisation to exercise plan making delegations in relation to this proposal.
- 3. Subject to the Gateway determination, community consultation for the planning proposal be undertaken.

In accordance with this Council Resolution, consideration for a Gateway Determination is requested.

The intended outcome of the planning proposal is to enable the original intent of KLEP 2013 (Amendment No. 8), which is to facilitate a future one into 14 rural residential subdivision with a minimum lot size of one hectare at the site. The subject land is currently zoned RU2-Rural Landscape/E2-Environmental Conservation with a minimum lot size of forty (40) hectares and is proposed to be rezoned as R5-Large Lot Residential with a minimum lot size of one (1) hectare.

Please find enclosed a disc containing the Planning Proposal, Council Report associated with the proposed Amendment, and a completed information checklist.









It is also requested that the Secretary issue Council with written authorisation to exercise its plan making delegations in relation to this proposal. The completed Evaluation Criteria for the Delegation of Plan Making Functions form is also on the disc.
