I write to you in regard to planning proposal (PP_2018_PENRI_007_00) which relates to the land at the corner of Rodgers and Somerset Streets, Kingswood and comprises seven (7) lots, being Lots 137 – 143 in DP 14333. The planning proposal was requested to enable the redevelopment of the site by reclassifying the subject land from community to operational land and rezoning the site from RE1 Public Recreation to B4 Mixed Use.

On 14 March 2021, Council officers wrote to the Department to withdraw the request to make the planning proposal, so that Council would have the opportunity to undertake additional open space demand analysis in the context of on-going strategic planning for the East-West Corridor; the Greater Penrith to Eastern Creek (GPEC) Investigation Area, St Marys and the Quarter.
