Planning proposal PP_2020_BLACK_004_00 to amend State Environmental Planning Policy (Sydney Region Growth Centres) 2006

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 3.34(1) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to rezone Lot 17 Section 26 DP 1459, 115 Crown Street, Riverstone from SP2 Infrastructure (Educational Establishment) and R2 Low Density Residential to RE1 Public Recreation.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, I have determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the enclosed Gateway determination.

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the planning proposal's inconsistency with section 9.1 Directions 3.1 Residential Zones is justified in accordance with the terms of the Directions. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Council may still need to obtain the agreement of the Secretary to comply with the requirements of relevant section 9.1 Directions 2.6 Remediation of Contaminated Land, 4.3 Flood Prone Land and 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection. Council should ensure this occurs prior to public exhibition or prior to the plan being made as appropriate.

I have determined not to condition the Gateway for Council to be the local planmaking authority as the planning proposal seeks to amend a State Environmental Planning Policy (Sydney Region Growth Centres) 2006.

The amending local environmental plan (LEP) is to be finalised within eight months of the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request for the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment to draft and finalise the LEP should be made eight weeks prior to the projected publication date.

The state government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 3.32(2)(d) of the Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.
