Heritage Review (Amendment 5 to LEP 2015) – Submission of Final Draft Planning Proposal PP_2017_BLUEM-004_00

This letter is to advise that the Planning Proposal for draft Amendment 5 to LEP 2015 was adopted by Council at the 29 September 2020 Council meeting following public exhibition. Council now seeks approval for the plan to be notified.

The draft Planning Proposal was publicly exhibited for six weeks from 7 March - 18 April 2018, consistent with the requirements of the Gateway Determination dated 3 November 2017. Following public exhibition, at the 29 September 2020 Council meeting it was resolved (Minute No. 286) to adopt and make the draft amendment, with one exception as per below.

A Council motion was moved and adopted in regard to one item in the draft Planning Proposal; that the draft new heritage listing of 27 Hope Street, Blaxland (BX012) be deferred from the Planning Proposal in accordance with Section 3.36(3) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. This was to enable an independent heritage assessment, to determine its heritage significance.

This item has therefore been deferred from the draft Planning Proposal, pending completion of the independent heritage assessment. Once this assessment is complete, it will be reported to Council. We are anticipating being able to confirm the outcome of the assessment and subsequent recommendations following the presentation of a report to the 24 November 2020 Council meeting.
