Planning proposal PP_2020_COPAR_006_00 to amend Parramatta Local Environmental Plan 2011

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 3.34(1) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal amend planning controls at 8-14 Great Western Highway, Parramatta.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the enclosed Gateway determination.

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the planning proposal's inconsistency with section 9.1 Directions 4.1 Acid Sulfate Soils and 6.3 Site Specific Provisions are justified in accordance with the terms of the Directions. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Council may still need to obtain the agreement of the Secretary to comply with the requirements of relevant section 9.1 Direction 3.5 Development Near Regulated Airport and Defence Airfields and 7.5 Implementation of Greater Parramatta Priority Growth Area Interim Land Use and Infrastructure Implementation Plan. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

As the site is located within the area covered by a potential Special Infrastructure Contribution plan, I ask that Council please request the proponent to initiate discussions with the Department. I would also appreciate if Council could raise the matter of State infrastructure needs generated by the proposal when consulting State Agencies and forward these submissions to the Department to assist in discussion with the proponent.

It is noted that Council has requested to be authorised as the local plan-making authority. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have conditioned the Gateway for Council to be authorised as the local plan-making authority.

The amending local environmental plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office six weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment.

The state government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 3.32(2)(d) of the Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.
