Planning Proposal to amend Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (EP&A Act) for a planning proposal seeking to amend Wentworth LEP 2011 to permit rural residential development on part of Lot 1 DP 1193874, 'Kelso Station', Pooncarie Road, North Wentworth.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I note that the proposal seeks to zone the subject land to E4 Environmental Living. I have determined that it is more appropriate that the site be zoned to R5 Large Lot Residential. The planning proposal is to be amended to reflect this change prior to community consultation.

It is also noted that the site is identified as 'Flood Planning Area' in the *Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011*. A Flood Study and Floodplain Management Plan will need to be prepared in consultation with the Office of Environment and Heritage and the Office of Water to support the proposal prior to the commencement of community consultation.

Council will still need to obtain the agreement of the Department's Secretary to comply with the requirements of S117 Directions 1.2 Rural Zones, 1.5 Rural Lands and 4.3 Flood Prone Land. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

Plan making powers were delegated to Councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under Section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_WENTW _004_00): to permit rural residential development on part of Lot 1 DP 1193874, 'Kelso Station', Pooncarie Road, North Wentworth.

I, the Executive Director, Regions at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (EP&A Act) that an amendment to the *Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011* to permit rural residential development on part of Lot 1 DP 1193874, 'Kelso Station', Pooncarie Road, North Wentworth should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The planning proposal is to be amended to rezone the subject land to R5 Large Lot Residential rather than the proposed E4 Environmental Living. The amended proposal is to be resubmitted to the Department of Planning and Environment for approval prior to undertaking community or agency consultation.
- 2. Prior to undertaking community consultation, Council is to:
 - (a) prepare a Flood Study and Floodplain Management Plan that determines the extent and risks of potential flooding on the site and measures necessary to mitigate these risks; and
 - (b) seek advice from the NSW Office of Water and NSW Office of Environment and Heritage following the preparation of the Flood Study and Floodplain Management Plan and address any concerns and comments provided by these agencies.
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and to comply with the requirements of the relevant section 117 Directions:
 - NSW Aboriginal Lands Council
 - Office of Environment and Heritage
 - NSW Office of Water
 - NSW Department of Primary Industries Water, Agriculture, Lands and Fishing
 - Transport for NSW and Roads and Maritime Services
 - Fire and Rescue NSW
 - NSW Rural Fire Service
 - NSW State Emergency Service
 - Essential Energy / Transgrid

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the planning proposal prior to community consultation.

- 4. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the EP&A Act as follows:
 - the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of (a) 28 days; and
 - the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements (b) for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing Local Environmental Plans (Department of Planning and Environment 2016).
- 5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
