Proposal Summary :	The Planning Proposal seeks to amend the Port Macquarie-Hastings LEP 2011 to facilitate a greater range of signage in public areas by: • permitting 'advertising structures' with consent within Zone RE1 Public Recreation; • including additional exempt signage provisions; • rezoning five (5) surf lifesaving clubs from RE2 Private Recreation to RE1 Public Reserve and permitting 'restaurant or cafes' as an additional permitted use to recognise the existing use of the buildings for this purpose; and • rezoning two (2) marine rescue buildings from RE1 Public Recreation to SP2 Infrastructure (emergency services facility).
