The Planning Proposal includes maps that include the site and the current and proposed zonings and minimum lot size standards. A proposed LRA (Land Reservation Map) has also been included. For the purposes of exhibition it is recommended that additional current and proposed zoning and lot size maps that clearly highlight the subject land also be included.

Revised maps which comply with the Department's 'Standard Technical Requirements for LEP Maps' will also be needed prior to the making of the LEP.

The Planning Proposal has indicated a 14 day timeframe for community consultation. This public exhibition/community consultation period is considered appropriate given the low impact nature of the proposal.

If No, comment :	 The Planning Proposal and accompanying documentation are considered to satisfy the adequacy criteria by: 1. Providing appropriate objectives and intended outcomes; 2. Providing a suitable explanation of the provisions proposed by the LEP to achieve the outcomes; 3. Providing an adequate justification for the proposal; 4. Outlining a proposed community consultation program; and 5. Providing a nuthorisation to exercise its plan making delegations. As the Planning Proposal deals only with matters of local significance, it is considered appropriate that an authorisation to exercise plan making delegations be issued to Council. The RPA has provided a project time line which estimates that the LEP will be ready for submission to the Department for notification in May/June 2017. This is considered adequate and as such a 12 month time frame is recommended.

Limeburners Creek Nature Reserve. OEH have also requested that part of Lot 1 DP 1191860
be rezoned from RU2 Rural Landscape and E2 Environmental Conservation to E1 National
Parks and Nature Reserves to facilitate its future acquisition and addition to the National
Park estate.

	All of the subject lots either are mapped as either wholly containing SEPP 14 wetland or a
	large part of the site has been mapped as such. It is not anticipated that the rezoning of
	the lots will have any detrimental impact on the wetlands and will only assist in there long
	term protection. The planning proposal is therefore considered to be consistent with the provisions of the SEPP.
	SEPP 15 - Rural Landsharing Communities
	Lot 1 DP 1191860 contains an existing rural land sharing community. As the rezoning will
	only affect currently vacant land not utilised by the community, the planning proposal is

	This Direction applies as the rezoning of the subject lands to E1 National Parks and Nature Reserves will mean that such activities will be prohibited. Despite this, Lots 8, 108 & 186 DP 754441 have been identified on the NSW Trade and Investment Mineral resource Audit Map due to an abandoned quarry on the site. Any inconsistency with this direction however can considered to be of minor significance as the land has been acquired by NPWS and any future mining would be likely to be incompatible with its future likely use. It is recommended however that Council consult with NSW Department of Industry (Mineral Resources) following gateway determination.
