Proposal Summary: This Planning Proposal aims to:

1. Reclassify part of Lot 23 DP1140182 from Community Land to Operational Land under the

Local Government Act 1993;

2. Rezone part of Lot 23 DP1140182 from RE1 Public Recreation to R3 Medium Density

Residential; and

3. Apply a minimum lot size of 450m2 to part of Lot 23 DP1140182.

The planning proposal has been prepared to enable a future boundary adjustment between privately owned and Council owned land due to a change in the alignment of Ashford's

Watercourse.

6. That plan making delegations not be granted to Council due to the possible need to

extinguish easements or reserves applying to the land.

Supporting Reasons:

The Planning Proposal is supported as it will facilitate the rezoning of land to reflect its current use and apply consistent planning provisions to the land. The reduction of public land is negligible and the reclassification to 'community' will not affect the Gunnedah

community as a whole.
