Planning proposal (PP_2016_BROKE_001_00) to amend Broken Hill Local Environmental Plan 2013 – Proposed Animal Pound Facility – Lot 1 DP 1162606, Airport Road, Broken Hill

I am writing in response to your Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* in respect of the planning proposal to amend Schedule 1 'Additional Permitted Uses' of the Broken Hill Local Environmental Plan 2013 (LEP) to allow development for an animal pound facility at Lot 1 DP 1162606, Airport Road, Broken Hill.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination (Attachment 1).

The Minister delegated plan making powers to Councils in October 2012. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan (Attachment 2).

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 6 months from the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office (parliamentary.counsel@pco.nsw.gov.au) 10 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment (westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au) for administrative purposes.

All related files for the LEP Amendment, including Maps, Map Cover Sheet, Planning Proposal document, section 59 Reporting and GIS data, if available, must be submitted to the Department via the Planning Portal Website at https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/planning-tools/online-submission-planning-data.

To submit the data, Council is required to create an account and log in using these details.

In accordance with "A guide for the preparation of local environmental plans" attachment 5 – Delegated plan making reporting template (Attachment 3) is enclosed for Council's information. Table 2 of the attachment is to be completed and included in Council's section 59 submission and forwarded to the westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au when requesting the planning proposal be finalised.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act, 1979* if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning Proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_BROKE_001_00): to amend Broken Hill Local Environmental Plan 2013 - Proposed Animal Pound Facility - Lot 1 DP 1162606 Airport Road, Broken Hill.

I, the Director Regions, Western at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979 (EP&A Act) that an amendment to the Broken Hill Local Environmental Plan 2013 (LEP) to permit an animal pound facility at Lot 1 DP 1162606, Airport Road Broken Hill, should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the EP&A Act as follows:
 - (a) The planning proposal is required to be made publicly available on exhibition for 14 days as described in A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013).
 - (b) The relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs.

No consultation is required with agencies.

- 2. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 3. Prior to the submission of the planning proposal under section 59 of the EP&A Act the final LEP Additional Permitted Use Map is to be compliant with the Department's "Standard technical requirements for datasets and maps".
- 4. The planning proposal is to be finalised within 6 months of the Gateway Determination date.
