

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2018_GRIFF_001_00): Additional Permitted Use for Lot 641 DP751743, 161 Remembrance Drive, Griffith.

I, the Director Regions, Western at the Department of Planning and Environment, as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 3.34(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) that an amendment to the Griffith Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2014 to Schedule 1 Additional Permitted Uses to permit with consent 'office premises', at 161 Remembrance Drive, Griffith, should proceed subject to the following conditions:

1. Before community consultation, the planning proposal is to be updated to reflect the removal of “educational facility” as an additional permitted use.
2. Public exhibition is required under section 3.34(2)(c) and schedule 1 clause 4 of the Act as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the planning proposal authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A guide to preparing local environmental plans* (Department of Planning and Environment 2016).
3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities / organisations under section 3.34(2)(d) of the Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant section 9.1 Directions, 2.1 Environmental Zones and 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection:
 - Office of Environment and Heritage.
 - Rural Fire Service.

Each public authority/organisation is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 3.34(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

5. The planning proposal authority is authorised as the local plan-making authority to exercise the functions under section 3.36(2) of the Act subject to the following:
 - a. the planning proposal authority has satisfied all the conditions of the Gateway determination;
 - b. the planning proposal is consistent with section 9.1 Directions or the Secretary has agreed that any inconsistencies are justified; and
 - c. there are no outstanding written objections from public authorities.
6. The time frame for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** following the date of the Gateway determination.
7. Prior to submission of the planning proposal under section 3.36 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, the final LEP maps including an “additional permitted use” map, must be prepared and be compliant with the Department’s ‘Standard Technical Requirements for Spatial Datasets and Maps’ 2017.
