Planning proposal (PP_2016_CABON_001_00) to rezone land zone R1 General Residential to zone B2 Local Centre and RE1 Public Recreation and insert the boundary adjustment subdivision clause

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land at Lot 272 DP 750170 from zone R1 General Residential to B2 Local Centre, rezone the adjoining Crown reserve from zone R1 General Residential to zone RE1 Public Recreation at Hill Street Molong, and insert the boundary adjustment subdivision model clause.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined that the planning proposal should proceed, subject to conditions in the attached Gateway determination (Attachment 1).

Prior to community consultation being undertaken Council is to consult with the NSW Rural Fire Service and obtain agreement of the Department's Secretary (delegate) to comply with requirements of section 117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection (refer to Condition No. 1 of the Gateway determination).

The Minister delegated plan making powers to Councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan (Attachment 2).

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office (parliamentary.counsel@pco.nsw.gov.au) 10 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment (westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au) for administrative purposes.

All related files for the LEP Amendment, including Maps, Map Cover Sheet, Planning Proposal document, section 59 Reporting and GIS data, if available, must be submitted to the Department via the Planning Portal Website at https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/planning-tools/online-submission-planning-data.

To submit the data, Council is required to create an account and log in using these details.

In accordance with "A guide for the preparation of local environmental plans" attachment 5 – Delegated plan making reporting template (Attachment 3) is enclosed for Council's information. Table 2 of the attachment is to be completed and included in Council's section 59 submission and forwarded to the westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au when requesting the planning proposal be finalised.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979* if the timeframes outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_CABON_001_00): to amend the Cabonne Local Environmental Plan 2012 - Rezone land at Lot 272 DP 750170 and the adjoining Crown Reserve from R1 General Residential to B2 Local Centre and RE1 Public Recreation respectively, and insert Clause – Boundary adjustments in certain rural and environmental management zones.

I, the Director Regions, Western at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* that the amendment to the Cabonne Local Environmental Plan 2012 (LEP) to amend the Cabonne Local Environmental Plan 2012 - Rezone land at Lot 272 DP 750170 and the adjoining Crown Reserve from R1 General Residential to B2 Local Centre and RE1 Public Recreation respectively, and insert Clause – Boundary adjustments in certain rural and environmental management zones should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to community consultation being undertaken consultation is required with the NSW Rural Fire Service under Section 56 (2)(d) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 to comply with the requirements of section 117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection. Council is to forward the NSW Rural Fire Service response to the Department and seek approval to proceed to community consultation.
 - The NSW RFS is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the planning proposal.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 as follows:
 - a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; and
 - b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).
- 3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979*. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

- 4. The final LEP maps shall be prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Department's "Standard Technical Requirements for Spatial Datasets and Maps" (2015).
- 5. The final timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the date of Gateway determination.
