Dear Mr Harding,

Planning Proposal (PP_2017_CABON_002_00) to amend Cabonne Council Local Environmental Plan 2013 411 Lower Lewis Pond Road, Clifton Grove.

I am writing in response to Council's letter dated 3 July 2017 requesting a Gateway determination under Section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 in respect of the Planning Proposal to rezone Lot 9 DP 243046, 411 Lower Lewis Ponds Road, Clifton Grove from RU1 Primary Production to R5 Large Lot Residential.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the Planning Proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination. (Attachment 1).

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the Planning Proposal's consistency with Section 117 Directions 1.2 Rural Zones, 1.5 Rural Lands, 2.3 Heritage Conservation Areas, 3.1 Residential Zones, Integrating Land Use and Transport.

The inconsistency with Section 117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection can be addressed after consultation with NSW Rural Fire Service and provided with the Section 59 Report- refer to condition 3. The inconsistency with Section 5.1 Implementation of Regional Strategies can be addressed prior to community consultation- refer to condition 1. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Plan making powers were delegated to Councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan. (Attachment 2).

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to

commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office (parliamentary.councel@pco.nsw.gov.au) 10 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

All related files for LEP Amendment, including PDF Maps, Map Cover Sheet, Planning Proposal document and GIS Data, if available, must be submitted to the Department via the Planning Portal Website at https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/planning-tools/online-submission-planning-data. To submit the data, Council is required to create an account and log in using these details.

A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment (<u>westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au</u>) for administrative purposes.

In accordance with "A guide for the preparation of local environmental plans" attachment 5 – Delegated plan making reporting template (<u>Attachment 3</u>) is enclosed for Council's information. Table 2 of the attachment is to be completed and included in Council's Section 59 submission and forwarded to the <u>westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au</u> when requesting the planning proposal be finalised.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under Section 54(2)(d) of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act, 1979* if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning Proposal (Department Ref: PP_2017_CABON_002_00): to rezone Lot 9 DP 243046, 411 Lower Lewis Ponds Road, Clifton Grove from RU1 Primary Production to R5 Large Lot Residential and change the minimum lot size to 2ha.

I, the Director Regions, Western, at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under Section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979* that an amendment to the Cabonne Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2013 to rezone Lot 9 DP 243046, 411 Lower Lewis Ponds Road, Clifton Grove from zone RU1 Primary Production to zone R5 Large Lot Residential and change the minimum lot size to 2ha should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Prior to community consultation the planning proposal is to be amended to address Section 117 Direction 5.10 - Implementation of Regional Plans. This work is to address the final Central West and Orana Regional Plan.
- 2. Community consultation is required under Sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act*, 1979 as follows:
 - (a) the Planning Proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **14 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in Section 5.5.2 of A guide to preparing local environmental plans (Department of Planning and Environment 2016).
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities and / organisations under Section 56(2)(d) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* and / or comply with the requirements of relevant Section 117 Directions:
 - NSW Office of Environment and Heritage
 - NSW Rural Fire Service
 - Orange City Council
 - NSW Department of Primary Industries Water

Each public authority/organisation is to be provided with a copy of the Planning Proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

- 4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under Section 56(2)(e) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979*. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 5. Prior to submission of the planning proposal under Section 59 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979*, the final LEP maps must be prepared and be compliant with the Department's 'Standard Technical Requirements for Spatial Datasets and Maps' 2015.

6.	The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months following the date of the Gateway
	determination.
