1 Name of Plan

2 Commencement

3 Land to which Plan applies

This Plan applies to Lot 114, DP 756310, 227 Augustus Street, Deniliquin.

4 Amendment of Deniliquin Local Environmental Plan 2013

(1) Schedule 1 Additional permitted uses

Number the clause headed "Use of certain land at 321 Victoria Street, Deniliquin" as clause 1.

(2) Schedule 1, clause 2

Insert at the end of the Schedule:

2 Use of certain land at 227 Augustus Street, Deniliquin

- (1) This clause applies to land at 227 Augustus Street, Deniliquin (being Lot 114, DP 756310) identified as "1" on the Additional Permitted Uses Map.
- (2) Development for the purpose of general industry (limited to the manufacture of precast concrete components) is permitted with development consent.
