Please refer to the answer below regarding the planning proposal related to the "Service Station" and "Highway Service Centre".

Regarding the 1% AEP hydraulic categorisation of the floodplain, the lots west to River Rd has been classified entirely as a flood fringe area whereas the lots east to River Rd are either flood fringe with small portions of flood storage.

Development in flood fringe areas would not have any significant effect on the pattern of flood flows and/or flood levels, however a reduction of the capacity of a flood storage area would cause a significant redistribution of flood flows. Hence, it is confirmed that any new development related to this planning proposal is subject to development controls stablished in the Forbes DCP.
