Planning proposal to amend Holroyd Local Environmental Plan 2013

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 6 March 2017 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to rezone part of Lot 11 DP 1162280 at Butu Wargun Drive, Pemulwuy.

As delegate of the Greater Sydney Commission, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination. I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the planning proposal is consistent with the section 117 Directions. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Commission may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2017_CUMBE_002_00): to rezone part of Lot 11 DP 1162280 at Butu Wargun Drive, Pemulwuy from R4 High Density Residential to R3 Medium Density Residential and to amend the building height provisions from 12.5m to 10m, the floor space ratio provisions from 0.85:1 to 0.7:1 and to amend the minimum lot size provisions from 900sqm to 300sqm.

I, the Director, Sydney Region West, at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Greater Sydney Commission, have determined under section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) that an amendment to the *Holroyd Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2013* to rezone part of Lot 11 DP 1162280 from R4 High Density Residential to R3 Medium Density Residential and to amend the building height provisions from 12.5m to 10m, the floor space ratio provisions from 0.85:1 to 0.7:1 and to amend the minimum lot size provisions from 900sqm to 300sqm should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to public exhibition, Council must revise the planning proposal to include the following maps:
 - a. current and proposed Land Zone Map;
 - b. current and proposed Height of Buildings Map;
 - c. current and proposed Floor Space Ratio Map; and
 - d. current and proposed Lot Size Map.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Act as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2016)* and must be made publicly available for a minimum of **14 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2016).
- 3. Consultation is required with the Office of Environment and Heritage under section 56(2)(d) of the Act. The Office of Environment and Heritage is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.
- 4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
