The amendments include mapping amendments to the Land Zoning, Lot Size, Height of Building and Heritage map to correct errors and anomalles; amendments to Schedule 5 Environmental Heritage to correct inaccuracies in the listing heritage items; and An amendment to the wording in clause 7.1 Acid Sulfate Soils.

The NSW Office of Environment and Heritage in relation to the heritage listing of Hammonds Cottage at Woody Head; d. The NSW Rural Fire Service in relation to S117 Direction 4.4; and e.
