Dear Mr Stonestreet,

Planning proposal (PP\_2016\_GRIFF\_001\_00) to amend Griffith Local Environmental Plan 2014 – Additional Permitted Use at 912 Kidman Avenue, Griffith.

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 13 October 2016 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) in respect of the planning proposal to identify an Additional Permitted Use for a "general industry" under Schedule 1 of the Griffith LEP 2014 at 912 Kidman Avenue, Griffith.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, that the planning proposal is consistent with section 117 Directions 1.1 Business and Industrial Zones and 6.3 Site Specific Provisions. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office (<a href="mailto:parliamentary.counsel@pco.nsw.gov.au">parliamentary.counsel@pco.nsw.gov.au</a>) 10 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment (<a href="mailto:westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au">westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.au</a>) for administration purposes.

All related files for the LEP Amendment, including Maps, Map Cover Sheet, Planning Proposal document, section 59 Reporting and GIS data, if available, must be submitted to the Department via the Planning Portal Website at <a href="https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/planningtools/online-submission-planning-data">https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/planningtools/online-submission-planning-data</a>. To submit the data, Council is required to create an account and log in using these details.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

## **Gateway Determination**

**Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP\_2016\_GRIFF\_001\_00)**: to identify 'general industry' as an Additional Permitted Use under Schedule 1 of the Griffith LEP 2014 at Lot 546 DP 751709, 912 Kidman Avenue, Griffith.

I, the Acting Director Regions, Western, at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) that an amendment to the Griffith Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2014 to identify 'general industry' under Schedule 1 Additional Permitted Use should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Council is required to create an 'Additional Permitted Uses' Map showing all items listed under Schedule 1 of the Griffith LEP 2014.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
  - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
  - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2013).
- 3. No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act
- 4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **9 months** following the date of the Gateway determination.
- 6. The final LEP maps shall be prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Department's "Standard Technical Requirements for Spatial Datasets and Maps" (2015).
