Macquarie Place is a place of great importance and historical significance and is also a small park offering major recreational benefit for the northern sector of the city. It is extensively overshadowed at present and, combined with its heavy pedestrian use, is under threat of losing more of its vegetation. If this were to happen, its character would change to a paved square.

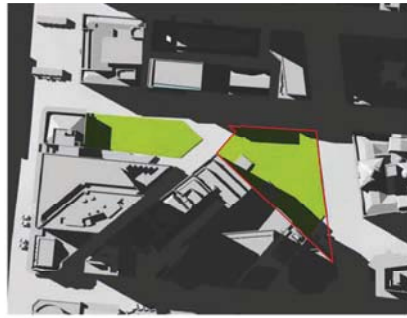

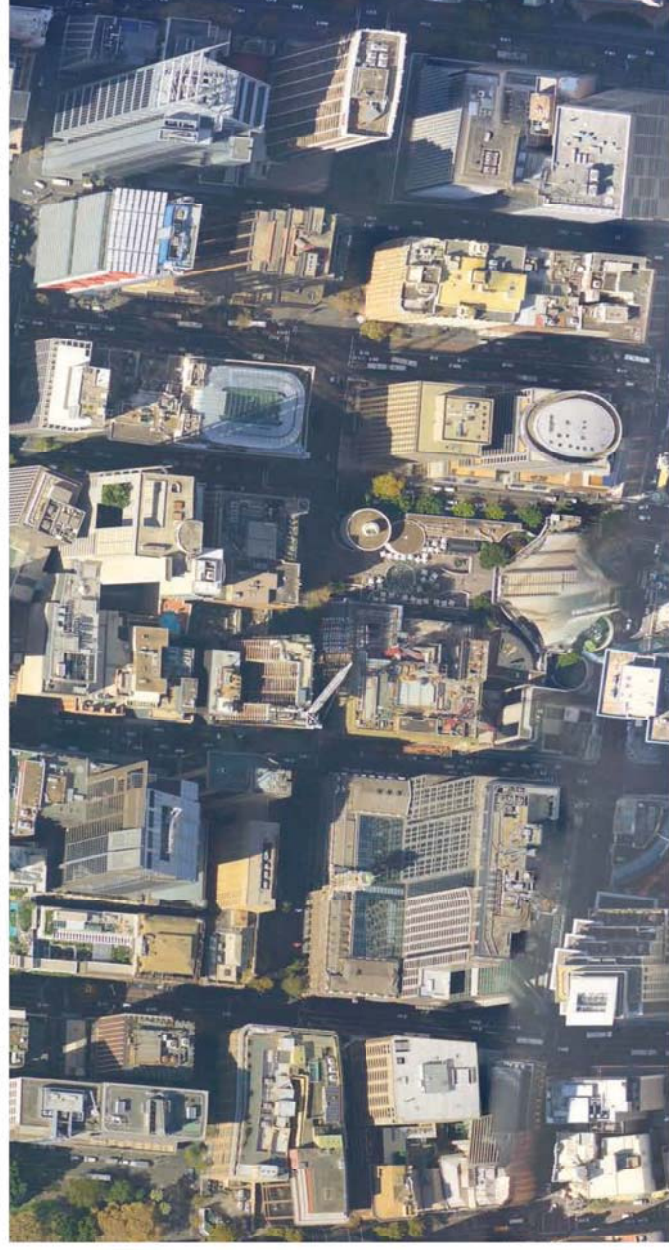


Martin Place

Martin Place has great cultural significance due to the important buildings which line this public space and the Cenotaph which is prominently located within it. It receives extensive all day pedestrian usage and intensive lunchtime use with frequent entertainment activities. The east west orientation of Martin Place limits sunlight access to the ground plane.

However, the shafts of light which penetrate along the north-south crossing streets or onto the facades of buildings on the south side become very important in providing some indirect light.

Martin Place is currently subject to both existing SAP and NAO controls. SAP controls are set for 14th April at 12pm. NAO controls are set for Martin Place West with dates set for between 14 April and 31 August between 12pm-2pm.

Martin Place Axonometric

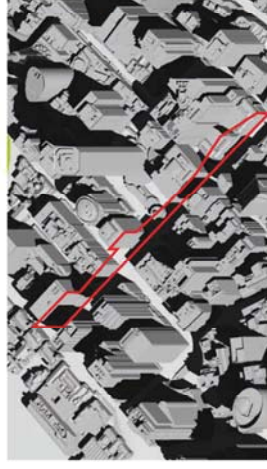

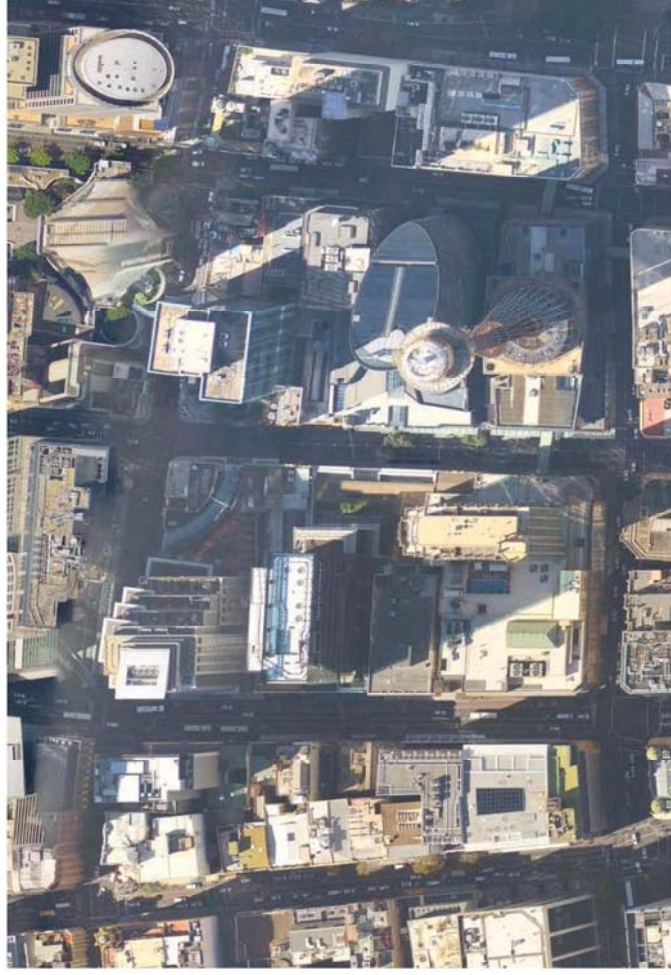


Pitt Street Mall

Pitt Street Mall was created specifically for pedestrians, and as a respite for shoppers and other pedestrians to enjoy outdoor activities and entertainment. It is at the heart of Central Sydney's retail core. Pedestrian activity is greatest around the lunchtime period, however existing sunlight access is greatest just before lunchtime. The Mall is used all day on weekends and by many people apart from office workers during the week.

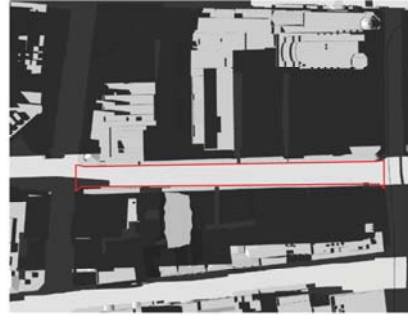

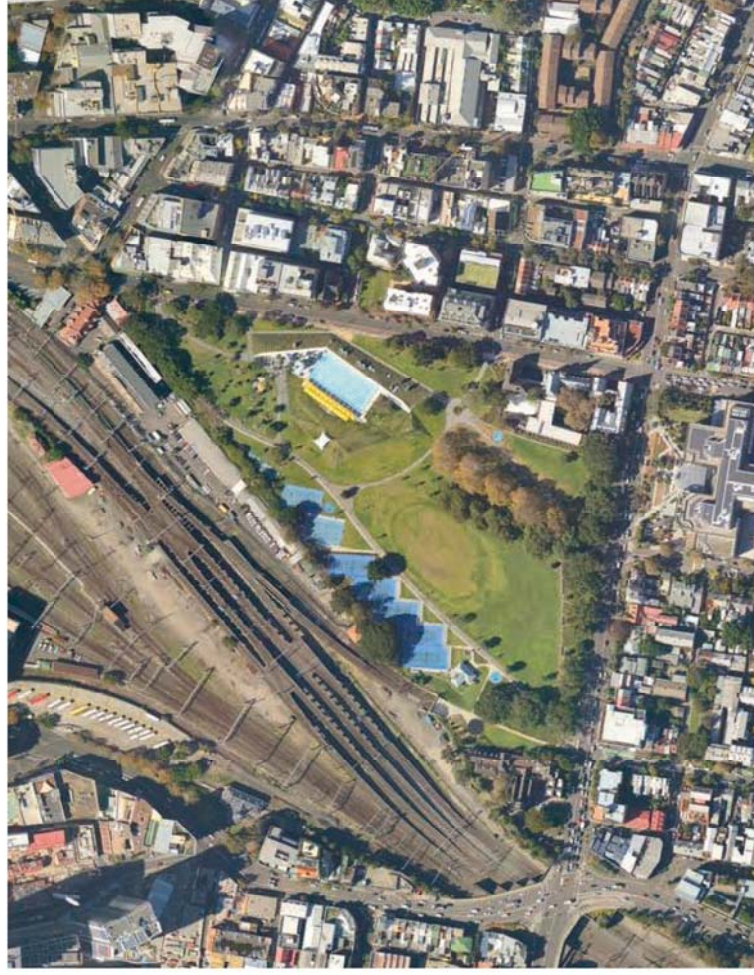


Prince Alfred Park

Sydney Square

Sydney Square is defined as the area between the Town Hall, St Andrews Cathedral, Town Hall House, the Cathedral Offices and around the Town Hall steps out to the edge of the footpath on George and Druiitt Streets. As well as the lunchtime use of the Square, it contains important ceremonial and symbolic elements, particularly the all day Town Hall steps - the most important civic space in Sydney and a popular meeting place - and the porch to St Andrews Cathedral.

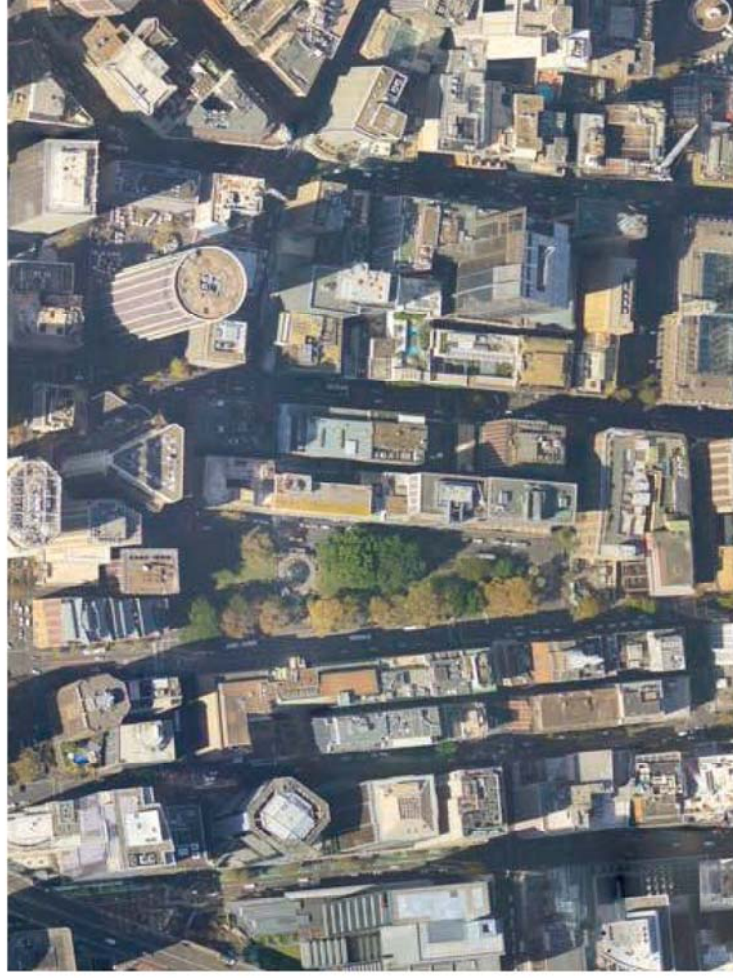


Wynyard Park
